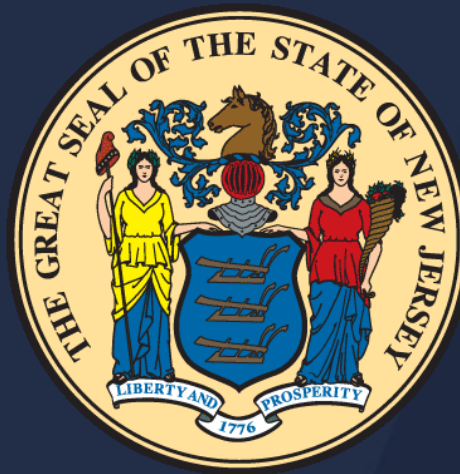


New Jersey Graduated Driver Licensing Law



NJ Graduated Driver Licensing Law

Permit At 16 (6 hrs. BTW) Or 17

Practice for at least 6 months

Probationary License At 17

Practice at least 12 months



Permit & Probationary Restrictions

DRIVING HOURS (NO DRIVING BETWEEN) work/religious exceptions allowed	11:01PM – 5:00AM
PASSENGERS Unless teen is accompanied by Parent/Guardian or the passengers are the teen driver's dependents (children)	NO MORE THAN ONE (1) PASSENGER
GDL DECAL	REQUIRED
PORTABLE ELECTRONIC DEVICES	NOT ALLOWED
SEATBELTS	REQUIRED

Kyleigh's Law

TDSC Report March 2008

Law Enacted April 15, 2009

Effective May 1, 2010



Objective

Identify GDL holders to facilitate enforcement and increase compliance of the GDL's lifesaving restrictions



Decal Requirement

Must be placed on any vehicle driven by GDL holder

Placement on front and rear license plates

Removable

\$4.00 per set

\$100 fine for failure to display

No Crime associated with use

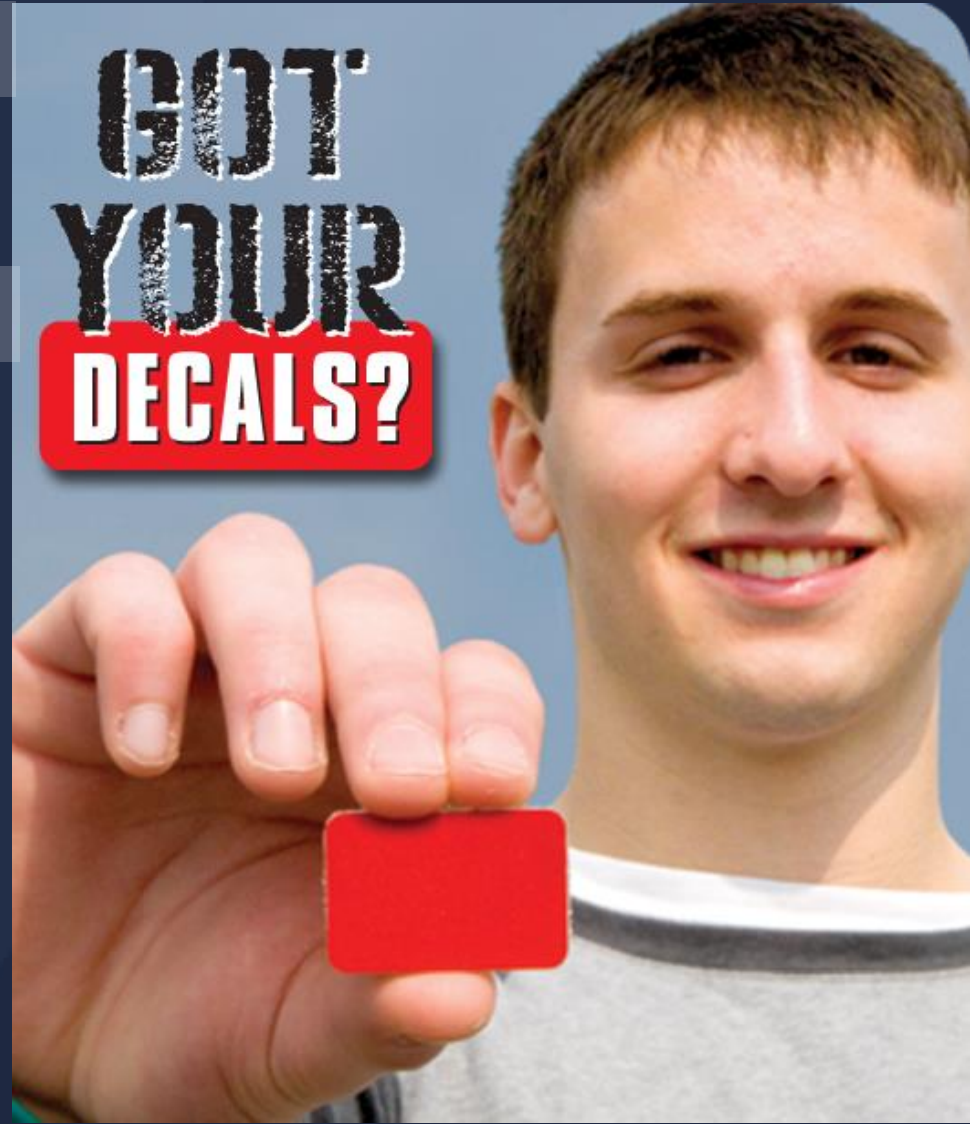
Research

14% Increase in Enforcement

Reduced teen driver crashes statewide by 9.5%

Prevented 3,197 teen driver crashes

Not associated with change in Permit Phase (Crash/Violation)
